



## MyGaze Assistive 2 eye gaze camera end of sale

The MyGaze Assistive 2 camera is to be withdrawn from sale in Q2 2018.

The product will be withdrawn from our range due to a recent takeover of SMI, the manufacturers of the camera by Apple. As a result of this takeover, SMI will permanently end production later this year.

We have purchased a large amount of stock that will enable us to continue supplying the device until Spring of 2018 – the precise time will be determined by the demand.

Until then we will continue to supply the camera with our Grid Pad Eye 11, 13 and 18 devices, and as a standalone device.

We would like to reassure you that the camera is not being withdrawn because of any quality or performance reasons.

As an unforeseen incident we apologise for not being able to provide our usual 12-month end of sale notice period, but will continue to fulfil orders for as long as we can.
